#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Rob Molacek with DNRC presents facts about document revision for EWP and answers questions about the EWP flood relief program.

- → Break down of total contribution amount to be dispensed if EWP is approved:
  - ◆ 75% of total fund amount for construction cost
  - ◆ 25% Sponsor of construction cost
  - ◆ 7.5% Technical Assistance
  - Still in process of finalizing agreement
  - Conservation District coordinates ALL agreements and permissions with landowner with the exception of final acceptance and construction for the program.
  - ◆ financial concerns as many great questions lead to more clear understanding of program specifics.

Then Stillwater will hire a temporary person to handle permits and other daily duties of the position, as Jessica took the full time position with Carbon Conservation. This could help relieve financial concerns in the district.
